**FOOD SAFETY ACT  
(CAP. 449)**

**Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs  
(Amendment) Regulations, 2004**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 10 of the Food Safety Act, the Minister of Health, the Elderly and Community Care has made the following regulations:-

**1.** The title of these regulations is the Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs (Amendment) Regulations, 2004, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Labelling, Presentation and Advertising of Foodstuffs Regulations, 2002, hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”. Citation. L.N. 5 of 2002.

**2.** These regulations implement the provisions of Commission Directive 2004/5/EC amending Directive 2001/15/EC to include certain substances in the Annex.

**3.** The following shall be added to the Seventh Schedule of the principal regulations: Amends the Seventh Schedule of the principal regulations

3. (1) In the Section concerning category 2. minerals, the following line is added under the heading CALCIUM:
