(CAP. 427)****Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction
of Chemicals (REACH) (Implementation) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2009**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister of Finance, the Economy and Investment, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, has made the following regulations:-

1. The title of these regulations is the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) (Implementation) (Amendment) Regulations, 2009, and they shall be read and construed as one with the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) (Implementation) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”.

2. These regulations implement the provisions of Article 31(5) of Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), establishing a European Chemicals Agency, amending Directive 1999/45/EC and repealing Council Regulation (EEC) No. 793/93 and Commission Regulation (EC) No. 1488/94 as well as Council Directive 76/769/EEC and Commission Directives 91/155/EEC, 93/ 67/EEC, 93/105/EC and 2000/21/EC.

Scope.

3. Immediately after regulation 5 of the principal regulations there shall be added the following new regulation:

Adds new regulation to the principal regulations.

“Language requirements for Safety Data Sheets.

6. With reference to Article 31(5) of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 the safety data sheet shall be supplied in at least one of the following languages:

Maltese, English, Italian.”
