

L.N. 214 of 2009**PRODUCT SAFETY ACT
(CAP. 427)****Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and
Mixtures (CLP) (Implementation) Regulations, 2009**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 38 to 40 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister of Finance, the Economy and Investment, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, has made the following regulations:-

1. (1) The title of these regulations is the Classification, Labelling and Packaging of Substances and Mixtures (CLP) (Implementation) Regulations, 2009. Title and scope.

(2) These regulations implement the provisions of articles 43, 44, 45, 47, 60, 61 and 62 of Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

2. (1) The Malta Standards Authority is the competent authority and enforcement authority within the meaning of Article 43 of Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures, amending and repealing Directives 67/548/EEC and 1999/45/EC, and amending Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008"). Establishment of the competent authority and enforcement authority.

(2) The Malta Standards Authority shall be the authority responsible for the provisions prescribed in Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008, Title VI, Competent Authorities and Enforcement.

3. The penalties applicable for infringement of the provisions of Regulation (EC) No.1272/2008 shall be those provided for in the Product Safety Act, Part IV. Penalties.
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
