

**L.N. 224 of 2010****PRODUCT SAFETY ACT  
(CAP. 427)****Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for  
Energy-Using Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2010**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by articles 38 to 40 of the Product Safety Act, the Prime Minister, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, has made the following regulations:–

**1.** (1) The title of these regulations is the Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign (Amendment) Requirements for Energy-Using Products Regulations, 2010. and they shall be read and construed as one with the Framework for the Setting of Ecodesign Requirements for Energy-Using Products Regulations, hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”.

Citation and scope.

(2) These regulations apply to the requirements of the following:

(a) Commission Regulation (EC) No 640/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to eco-design requirements for electric motors;

(b) Commission Regulation (EC) No 641/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to eco-design requirements for glandless standalone circulators and glandless circulators integrated in products;

(c) Commission Regulation (EC) No 642/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to eco-design requirements for televisions;

(d) Commission Regulation (EC) No 643/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard

to ecodesign requirements for household refrigerating appliances.

Amends regulation 2 of the principal regulations.

**2.** In sub-regulation (2) of regulation 2 of the principal regulations, immediately after paragraph (h) thereof, there shall be added the following:

“(i) products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 640/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for electric motors;

(j) products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 641/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for glandless standalone circulators and glandless circulators integrated in products;

(k) products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 642/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for televisions;

(l) products within the meaning of Commission Regulation (EC) No 643/2009 of 22 July 2009 implementing Directive 2005/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to ecodesign requirements for household refrigerating appliances.”.

Amends regulation 3 of the principal regulations.

**3.** For the definition “the Directorate” in regulation 3 of the principal regulations, there shall be substituted the following:

“ “the Directorate” means the Regulatory Affairs Directorate of the Malta Standards Authority, as established by virtue of the Establishment of Directorates of the Malta Standards Authority Order;”.

Amends regulation 6 of the principal regulations.

**4.** Regulation 6 of the principal regulations shall be amended as follows:

(a) in paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (2) thereof, for the words “Director of Consumer Affairs” there shall be substituted the words “Director of Market Surveillance”; and

(b) in paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (3) thereof, for the words “Director of Consumer Affairs” there shall be substituted the words “Director of Market Surveillance”.

**5.** In regulation 10 of the principal regulations, the words “Director of Consumer Affairs”, wherever they occur, shall be substituted with the words “Director of Market Surveillance”.
