

**FISHERIES (PROHIBITION OF TRAWL FISHING) ORDER G.N. 13/1976**  
*under s. 39*

1. This Order may be cited as the Fisheries (Prohibition of Trawl Fishing) Order. Citation

2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpreta-  
tion

“trawl net” means any bag-shaped net which in the course of operation is towed or pulled by mechanical means through the water, whether on the bottom or not, for the purpose of catching fish;

“bottom trawl net” means any trawl net which, when in operation has any part of it touching the ground;

“Area A” is that portion of Lake Malawi south of a line on a bearing of 96° from Point 4 through Point 3 in the Schedule to this Order.
