1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations.

Interpreta-tion

Citation

- 2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires-
- "area" means any expanse, or any part of the course of any waters, as the case may be, which is specified and delineated for the purposes of these Regulations in accordance with directions in that behalf contained in the Tenth Schedule;
- "area catch rate" means the area catch rates as worked out in Part I of the Fourth Schedule;
- "bottom trawl net" means any trawl net which, when in operation, has any part of it touching the ground;

# Fisheries. Fisheries (Commercial Fishing) Regulations

- "horse power" means the maximum horse power of any engine as defined by the manufacturer and expressed as brake horsepower, hereinafter referred to as b.h.p.;
- "chambo" means any fish of the following species-Tilapla squamipinnis, Tilapia saka, Tilapia lidole and Tilapia karongae.
- "chirimila net" means a partially encircling fishing net basically and traditionally used in Lake Malawi to catch species of Haplochromis;
- "cod end" means the bag of a trawl or seine net into which fish is thrown and is held whilst the net is in motion;
- "commercial fishing licence fee" bears the meaning ascribed to that term by regulation 9;
- "deep waters" means all waters which are deeper than 46.2 metres (25 fathoms);
- "Domira Area" means the area prescribed in Part II of the Tenth Schedule;
- "footrope" means any rope or line which, when a fishing net is in use or lies normally in the water, is attached to the lower part of that net and, in the case of a moving net, the leading edge of that lower part;
- "gill net" means any static or drifting net which is used to catch fish by enmeshing or entangling them;
- "headrope" means any rope or line which, when a fishing net is in use or lies normally in the water, is attached to the upper part of that net and, in the case of a moving net, the leading edge of that upper part;
- "headrope length" means the length of the upper part of any fishing net as mounted or attached to the headropes;
- "length of trawl net" shall be the total length of netting behind the centre of the headrope when stretched in the direction the netting is made;
- "Lower Shire Area" that part of the Shire River below Kapachira falls to the Mozambique border and its associated waters;
- "midwater trawl net" means a trawl net which when in use does not touch the ground;
- "net mesh size" means the size of mesh which, when lightly stretched in the direction in which the netting is made, allows a tapered gauge not exceeding 1.4 mm (1/16°) in thickness and of a breadth equal to the specified size to pass easily through when the net is wet;
- "net mouth" means the entrance or opening of any trawl net;
- "net mouth size" means the total length of footrope, headrope and any mounting rope fastened between them at the edges of a net mouth;

#### (Subsidiary)

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- "ring net" means any seine net which is not operated from the shore;
- "seine net" means any net used to catch fish by surrounding them;
- "shore seine net" means any seine net partly or wholly operated from the shore;
- "South East Arm" means the area prescribed in Part II of the Tenth Schedule;
- "South West Arm" means the area prescribed in Part II of the Tenth Schedule;
- "trawl net" means any bag-shaped net which in the course of operation is towed or pulled through the water by mechanical means, whether on the bottom or not, for the purpose of catching fish;
- "unit catch rate" means the relative fish catching ability of a fishing unit compared with that of any other fishing unit;

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"Upper Shire River" means that part of the Shire River between Lake Malawi and Lake Malombe.

Licensing of fishing business, commercial fishing licences 3. No person shall whether by himself or by his agent or servant operate or cause to be operated any ring, trawl, or chirimila net unless he has first registered his fishing business with the Principal Licensing Officer and has obtained a commercial fishing licence in the form set out in the Second Schedule:

Provided that no commercial fishing licences for a chirimila net shall be necessary if the applicant first applies to and is registered by the Principal Licensing Officer in compliance with the First Schedule, Part I of the Second Schedule and Part III of the Fifth Schedule.

Form of registration and application for a licence

- 4.—(1) An application for either registration for a fishing business or for a commercial fishing licence shall be in the form specified in the First Schedule.
- (2) The types and sizes for ring, trawl or chirimila net which may be used and the conditions, areas and times of their operation and the fees payable for registration and which shall be renewable on the 1st of April, each year, shall be those prescribed in Parts I, II and III of the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations.

Renewal of registration and licence

- 5.—(1) Every registration of a fishing business shall be valid for a period of one year in the first instance and may thereafter be renewed for a period not exceeding five years, after which time a new application for re-registration shall be made to the Principal Licensing Officer.
- (2) The renewal of registration of a fishing business shall be as specified in the Part I of the First Schedule and that of a

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commercial fishing licence shall be in the form specified in Part III of the Second Schedule.

- (3) Before recommending to the Minister the granting or refusal to grant a licence, the Principal Licensing Officer may require the applicant to furnish any further information as he may consider necessary,
- (4) The Minister may, on recommendation by the Principal Licensing Officer at any time attach to any licence such special conditions as may be considered necessary.
- 6. -(1) It shall be a general condition of every commercial General fishing licence that ---
  - (a) unless weather conditions render compliance impossible, fish being caught under the licence shalf be caught and landed at such place or places as are specified in the licence or in any O.N.

    135/1978 special conditions attached thereto:

conditions: commercial fishing

Provided always that the burden of proving the weather condions rendering the non-compliance shall always be with the licensee;

(b) the licensee shall, within seven days of the end of each G.N.

76/1976 month, render to the Chief Fisheries Officer a complete return in the form prescribed in the Twelfth Schedule, of fish caught under the ficence, the gear used, the area in and the depth fished and any other information the Chief Fisheries Officer may consider relevant;

- (c) the licensee shall keep such records as will, in the opinion of the Chief Fisheries Officer, enable the licensee to submit accurate returns and the licensee shall allow any Pisheries Officer to have access to such records at any reasonable time;
- (d) the licensee shall permit the Chief Fisherics Officer or any member of the Fisheries Department authorized by him, to take samples of tish from such licensee's catch for the purpose of carrying out scientific tests and experiments;
- (e) the licensee shall not operate a trawl net between 1700 and 0700 hours without the prior written consent of the Principal Licensing Officer;
- (f) the licensee shall, on the demand of any person duly authorized in that behalf by the Minister, produce any document relevant to owning and operating his fishing business;
- (g) the licensee shall not operate a trawl or ring net in waters within 1.85 kilometres (one nautical mile) off the shore of Lake Malawi;
- (h) the licensec shall not operate a trawl or ring net in waters less than 18.3 metres (10 fathoms) deep in Lake Malawi south of latitude 13° 42′ south.

Lisheries

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(2) For the purpose of this regulation the cod end length shall not be less than one-fourth and not greater than one-half of the stretch length of the trawl net.

Resocation of licence

7. The Principal Licensing Officer may at any time recommend to the Minister the revocation of any licence if the holder fails to comply with any of the provisions of the Fisheries Act or any subsidiary legislation made thereunder or any conditions which may be attached to his licence.

Transfer of

- 8. (1) No licence shall be transferrable without the prior written permission of the Principal Licensing Officer.
- (2) In the case of a licence issued to a company or partnership a transfer of control of the company or dissolution of the partnership shall terminate the validity of the licence unless the Principal Licensing Officer otherwise orders.

Fees

- **9.** (1) The annual fee payable for the registration of a fishing business shall be as set out in the Third Schedule.
- (2) The commercial fishing ficence fee which may be paid annually or monthly shall depend on the fishing unit authorized by the registration of the fishing business, the fishing gear used and where the fishing unit is permitted to be used, as prescribed in the Fourth Schedule.
- (3) The area catch rate multiplied by the unit catch rate and further multiplied by the basic fee shall be the formula to determine the annual fees which in the case of monthly fees shall be one-tenth thereof.
- (4) The Chief Fisheries Officer shall periodically review the basic fee, area catch rate and unit catch rate and shall cause the same to be published in the *Gazette*.
- (5) Where a licence grants the licensee the option of fishing in any two or more fishing areas, the fee payable shall be the highest in respect of any of such areas.

Catch limits

- 10. (1) The Principal Licensing Officer may at his discretion, subject to the Sixth Schedule, impose limits on the amount of fish which may be taken from any waters of Lake Malawi as prescribed in the Tenth Schedule.
- (2) Any limits set out under subregulation (1) shall in addition to being published in the *Gazette* be served on any licensee affected at least 30 days before the date such limits are to come into operation.

Registration of shore scine cets

11.—(1) No person shall whether by himself, his agent or his servant operate or cause to be operated a shore seine net with a headrope length exceeding 3 metres (9.8 feet) without first being registered by a Licensing Officer in the form prescribed in the Eleventh Schedule.

- (2) The types and sizes of shore seine nets which may be used and the conditions, areas and times of their operation and the fees payable for registration which shall be renewable on the 1st April each year, shall be those prescribed in the Seventh Schedule to these Regulations.
- 12. (1) No person shall whether by himself, his agent or Registration servant operate or cause to be operated a gill net without first of gill nets being registered by Licensing Officer in the form prescribed in the Eleventh Schedule.

- (2) The types and sizes of gill nets which may be used and the conditions, areas and times of their operation and the fees payable for registration which shall be renewable on the 1st April of each year, shall be those prescribed in the Eighth Schedule to these Regulations.
- 13. The Principal Licensing Officer may give written permission. Exceptions for the use of a specified number, length and depth of gill nets or shore some nets of a specified mesh size to be operated for a specified period in a specified area which may differ from the sizes, periods or areas stated in the Seventh or Fighth Schedules.
- 14. No person shall place or operate any static or drifting Buoys fishing gear unless it is clearly visible for a minimum of one and lights nautical mile (1.85 kilometres) and if operated between 1800 and 0600 hours displays a light on both ends of the gear.
- 15. No person shall place or operate any fishing gear in such Obstruction a manner as to cause obstruction to any waterway;

Provided that a waterway shall not be considered obstructed if one lifth of its width or a width of 6 metres (19.7 feet) whichever is less, over a depth of 3 metres (9.8 feet) is free from obstruction.

16. (1) No person shall take, kill, buy, sell, expose for sale or Minimum have in his possession any fish of less than the length prescribed allowed in the Ninth Schedule.

- (2) Any person who catches any fish, whether dead or alive, of less than the prescribed minimum length, shall immediately return the same to the water from which it was removed.
- (3) The Chief Lisheries Officer may give authority in writing to any person to take specified numbers and species of fish of less than the minimum prescribed length.

 The South West Arm is that portion of Lake Malawi lying west of the Nankhumba Peninsula and Domwe Island and of a line on a bearing of 9° from Point 6 to Point 1 and south of a line on a bearing of 93° from Point 9 to Point 1.

Area D is that part of the South West Arm lying south of a line bearing 53° from Point 7 to Point 6.

Area E is that part of the South West Arm lying north of a line bearing 53° from Point 7 to Point 6 but south of a line bearing 291° from Point 6 through Point 8.

Area F is that part of the South West Arm north of a line bearing 291° from Point 6 through Point 8.
