

## MOVEMENT OF FARM ANIMALS RULES

G.N.  
234/1968*under s. 8*

1. These Rules may be cited as the Movement of Farm Animals Rules. Citation

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation  
“farm animals” mean any cattle, sheep, goats, swine or poultry.

3. No farm animals shall be moved from one District to any other District without a permit authorizing such movement Restriction on movement  
granted under rule 4.

4.—(1) Every inspector is hereby authorized to issue permits under rule 3 and the Chief Veterinary Officer may appoint such other persons as he may think fit to issue such permits, and may direct the area for which such person may issue permits: Permits

Provided however that a permit for the movement of any farm animals infected with disease, or which have been in contact with any farm animals infected with disease, shall not be granted except by or with the sanction of a veterinary officer.

(2) Every permit shall be in the form in the Schedule.

5.—(1) The person to whom a permit for the movement of any farm animals shall have been granted shall be guilty of an offence if any breach of these Rules is committed by himself or his servants or agents. Possession of permits
