## III

In separate notifications, the Ministry of Forest and Environment has announced similar enhancement of fees under the 1977 Wild Life Sanctuary Rules, the 1979 Himalayan National Park Rules, and the 1987 Khaptad National Park Rules.

Fees for the use of elephants, prescribed in the Nepal Rajapatra (Vol. 34, No. 22) on Bhadra 25, 2041 (September 10, 1984) (Nepal recorder, Year 8, No. 35, September 17, 1984) have been changed as follows:
