(1) A person must not take any paua from the Huriawa Peninsula area.

- (2) In this clause, **Huriawa Peninsula area** means that area of South Island fisheries waters that lies within an area enclosed by a line—
 - (a) commencing at a point on the main high-water mark (at 45°38.44'S and 170°39.81'E); then
 - (b) proceeding north-west to a point 50 m offshore (at 45°38.41'S and 170°39.80'E); then
 - (c) proceeding generally east then west around the Huriawa Peninsula along a line every point of which is 50 m from the mean high-water mark to a point off-shore that is 50 m south of the mean high-water mark (at 45°38.57'S and 170°39.78'E); then
 - (d) proceeding north-west to a point (at 45°38.54'S and 170°39.77'E); then
 - (e) proceeding generally east then west along the mean high-water mark around the Huriawa Peninsula to the point of commencement.

Explanatory note
