Knobbed whelk( <i>Aus- trofusus glans</i> )	Quota management areas KWH1, KWH2, KWH3, KWH4, KWH5, KWH6, KWH7A, KWH7B, KWH8, and KWH9	<p>A commercial fisher may return any knobbed whelk to the waters from which it was taken if—</p> <p>(a) the knobbed whelk is likely to survive on return; and</p> <p>(b) the return takes place as soon as practicable after the knobbed whelk is taken.</p>

This order, which takes effect on 1 October 2006, inserts knobbed whelk into Schedule 6 of the Fisheries Act 1996 as stocks that may be returned to the sea in accordance with certain requirements.
