1 Title

These regulations are the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Amendment Regulations 2006.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 October 2006.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Fisheries (Satellite Vessel Monitoring) Regulations 1993.

4 Vessels required to carry and operate automatic location communicators Regulation 3(1) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (e):

"(ea) New Zealand fishing vessels of 28 metres or less in length that are used at any time during a fishing year in fishing for deepwater clam; and".
