Pursuant to section 297 of the Fisheries Act 1996, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

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Regulations

1 Title

(1) These regulations are the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Amendment Regulations 2005.

(2) In these regulations, the Fisheries (Infringement Offences) Regulations 2001

SR 2001/316

are called "the principal regulations".

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 30 June 2005.

3 Schedule 1 amended

Schedule 1 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting in the item relating to the Fisheries (Southland and Sub-Antarctic Areas Amateur Fishing) Regulations 1991 (SR 1991/57), in their appropriate order, the following items:

Provision	Description of offence	Fee (\$)
r 3A(4)	Taking or possessing blue cod in Milford or Doubtful Sounds contrary to the regulations	250
r 4AA(5)	Taking or possessing more than the daily limit of fish, but not more than 2 times the daily limit	250
r 4AA(5)	Taking or possessing more than 2 times the daily limit of fish, but not more than 3 times the daily limit	500
r 4AAB(3)	Possessing, using, or setting dahn lines, rock lobster pots, dredges, set nets, or blue cod pots contrary to the regulations	250
