- 1 Title
 - This notice is the Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications: Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission) Notice 2009.
- 2 Commencement
 - This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 3 Notification of global, regional, or sub-regional fisheries organisation or arrangement
 - For the purposes of Part 6A of the Fisheries Act 1996 and the definition of global, regional, or sub-regional organisation or arrangement in section 113B of that Act, the Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission is an agreement or arrangement within the meaning of that definition.
- 4 Notification of international conservation and management measures
 - For the purposes of Part 6A of the Fisheries Act 1996 and the definition of international conservation and management measures in section 113B of that Act, the conservation and management measures adopted by the Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission that are set out in the Schedule of this notice are measures within the meaning of that definition.
