

Royal Decree No. 26/2011 Establishing the Public Authority for Consumer Protection

We, Qaboos Bin Said, Sultan of Oman

After perusal of the Basic Law of the State, promulgated by the Royal Decree No. 101/96, and The Public Authorities and Organizations' Law, promulgated by the Royal Decree No.116/91, and And in pursuance of the public interest

Have decreed as follows:

Article One

A public authority named “the Public Authority for Consumer Protection” shall be established. It shall have legal personality and enjoy financial and administrative autonomous.

Article Two

Dr. Said Bin Khamis Al-Kaabi shall be appointed chairman of this Authority in the special grade.

Article Three

A Royal Decree on the law of the Authority shall be issued subsequently.

Article Four

This Decree shall be published in the Official Gazette and shall take effect as from the date of its publication.
