LAND ACQUISITION (SINDH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1992

An Ordinance to amend the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, in its application to the Province of Sindh

[Gazette of Sindh, Extraordinary, Part I, 7th July, 1992]

No.S.Legis.1(4)/92, dated 7-7-1992.—The following Ordinance by the Governor of Sindh is hereby published for general information:—

Preamble.--Whereas it is expedient to amend the Land Acquisition Act, 1894, in its application to the Province of Sindh in the manner hereinafter appearing;

And whereas the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:--

- 1. Short title.-(1) This Ordinance may be called the Land Acquisition (Sindh Amendment) Ordinance, 1992.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of section 18 of Act X of 1894.—In the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 in its application to the Province of Sindh, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 18, in subsection (3), for the words "the Provincial Government", the words and commas "The Federal Government, the Provincial Government, a Company or a local authority, as the case may be," shall be substituted.
- 3. Amendment of section 20 of Act X of 1894.--In the said Act, in section 20, in clause (c), for the words "and the Department of Government",

the words and comma "the Federal Government, the Provincial Government" shall be substituted.

- 4. Amendment of section 22-A of Act X of 1894.-In the said Act, in section 22-A, for the words and comma "The Provincial Government,", the words "The Federal Government or the Provincial Government" shall be substituted.
- 5. Amendment of section 31 of Act X of 1894.—In the said Act, in section 31, in subsection (1), for the words "the Provincial Government" wherever occurring, the words and commas "the Federal Government or the Provincial Government, as the case may be," shall be substituted.
- 6. Amendment of section 50 of Act X of 1894.—In the said Act, in section 50 in subsection (2), the colon may be replaced by the full-stop and the proviso shall be deleted.
