Regulation respecting the fees to be paid under section 106.6 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife
(chapter C-61.1, s. 106.6)

The fees prescribed in the Regulation have been indexed as of 1 April 2014 pursuant to the notice published in Part 1 (French) of the Gazette officielle du Québec of 26 October 2013, page 1182. (s. 2)

1. In this Regulation,

“agency” means an agency which is a signatory to a memorandum of agreement on the management of a controlled zone with the Minister of Natural Resources and Wildlife, pursuant to section 106 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1).

2. Every agency must, in accordance with section 106.6 of the Act, pay the non-profit legal person referred to in section 106.3 of that Act, for 2013, 2014 and 2015, a sum representing the total of the following amounts:

(1) a basic amount of [\\$1,176.57](#), plus 1.1% of the amount collected as membership fees by the agency, to travel about the territory under its management or to hunt, fish or carry on another recreational activity, during the fiscal year of the year preceding the current year by 2 years. That amount may not exceed [\\$5,187.81](#) for the year 2014;

(2) an amount of [\\$2](#) multiplied by the number of the agency's members in good standing.

The total of those 2 amounts may not exceed [\\$8,556.91](#) for the year 2014.

The amounts in subparagraph 1 of the first paragraph and the second paragraph are adjusted on 1 April of the subsequent years by applying to their value for the preceding year the annual percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) calculated for the month of June of the preceding year and published by Statistics Canada. If the percentage is negative, no adjustment is made.

The Minister is to publish the results of the adjustment in Part 1 of the Gazette officielle du Québec and may publicize more broadly using any other appropriate means.

3. The amount established pursuant to section 2 is paid by the agency in 2 equal annual instalments, on 1 June and on 1 October.
