Regulations, 2014**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Wild Animals and Birds Protection Act, 1961, the Minister for Environment and Energy makes the following Regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wild Animals and Birds Protection (Sheath-tailed Bat) Regulations, 2014. Citation
2. In these regulations unless the context otherwise requires — Interpretation
 - “Act” means the Wild Animals and Birds Protection, Act, 1961;
 - “activities” includes residential and commercial development, blasting, use of pesticides, lighting of fire, vegetation clearing, group visits, photographing, use of mist net and use of any noise emitting device, or machinery;
 - “Ministry” means the Ministry responsible for environment;
 - “roosting area” means an area where sheath-tailed bat rests, sleeps or reproduce;
 - “sheath-tailed bat” means the bat with the scientific name ‘*Coleura Seychellensis*’.
3. Sheath-tailed bat shall be a protected animal throughout Seychelles. Sheath-tailed bat declared protected

4. A person shall not —
- (a) disturb, catch, shoot, kill, possess or take any sheath-tailed bat, or
 - (b) purchase, sell or exhibit for sale, or export any part of or any live, preserved or stuffed sheath-tailed bat.

Prohibition
of entry or
activities

5. A person shall not knowingly or intentionally —
- (a) enter into any sheath-tailed bat roosting area; or
 - (b) do any activities in the vicinity of sheath-tailed bat roosting area,

without a written authorisation of the Ministry.

Offences and
penalties

6. Any person who contravenes regulation 4 or 5 shall on conviction be liable to the penalties provided under section 3 of the Act.
