In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 16(2) and 21 of the Licences Act, 1986, the President being the Minister responsible for Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licences Citation (Fisheries) Regulations, 1987.

2. In these Regulations — Interpretation "authorised officer" means an authorized officer designated for the purposes of the Fisheries Act, 1986; Act 5 of 1986 "SFA" means the Seychelles Fishing Authority established by the Seychelles Fishing Authority (Establishment) Act, Act 10 of 1984 1984: "Seychelles waters" means the exclusive economic zone, territorial waters, internal waters and all waters subject to the fisheries jurisdiction of Seychelles. Application 3. (1) An application for a licence required for the Act 5 of 1986 purpose of section 7 of the Fisheries Act, 1986 (hereafter referred to as a "foreign fishing vessel licence") shall be in the Form provided by the Authority. (2) An application for a licence required for the purpose of section 9 of the Fisheries Act, 1986, (hereafter referred to as a Act 5 of 1986 "local fishing vessel licence") shall be in the Form provided by the Authority. (3) An application for a licence when required under section 11 of the Fisheries Act, 1986, (hereafter referred to as a Act 5 of 1986 "fishing licence") shall be in the Form provided by the

(4) An application for a licence required for the purposes
 S.I. 35 of 1987 of regulation 10 of the Fisheries Regulations, 1986, (hereafter referred to a a "fishing net licence") shall be in the Form provided by the Authority.

Public bodies to be consulted 4. Before granting the licence for any of the purposes set out in regulation 3, the Authority shall consult —

(a) the SFA to ensure compliance with the Fisheries

5. A foreign fishing vessel licence and a local fishing vessel licence shall be subject to the conditions prescribed under the Fisheries Act, 1986.

6. A fishing licence to fish for any species of fish shall specify the species for which it is valid and the manner of disposal of the fish.

7. A fishing net licence shall specify the size of the net and the location and manner of the use of the net.

8. (1) An application made under regulation 3 shall, subject to subregulation (2), be accompanied by the fees set out in Schedule 1.

(2) A person who is the holder of a licence and who applies, after the expiration of the licence, for the same type of licence shall, unless the Authority is satisfied that he had, during the period between the expiration of his previous licence and his application, ceased to carry on the activity for which he was previously licensed, be liable in addition to the licence fee and any other per y under the Act, to a surcharge equal to 10% of the licence fee for each month or part thereof which has elapsed from the care of expiration of the previous licence and the date of the lodging of his application.

(3) Where the application is refused the Authority shall refund the licence fee and the surcharge to the applicant.
