Water Supply (Abstraction Licence) Regulations, 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 78 of the Water Act, 1982 the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Regulations—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Supply (Abstraction Licence) Regulations, 1984. Citation
2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation
“trade premises” means any premises used, in whole or in part, for any trade, business, industrial or commercial purposes but does not include a department or division of the Government or a non-profit making organisation.
3. The charges in relation to the abstraction of water shall be as set out in the Schedule. Charges for abstraction of water

SCHEDULE

1. For processing an application for a licence to abstract water R. 50
2. For a licence to abstract water to supply—
 - (a) a trade premises where the number of persons employed on the premises—
 - (i) does not exceed 5 R. 500 annually
 - (ii) exceeds 5 R.2000 annually
 - (b) any premises other than a trade premises R. 50 annually
