## EXPORT OF FISHERY PRODUCTS ACT

(Cap 77A)

**Export of Fishery Products (Sanitary) Regulations, 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Export of Fishery Products Act, the Minister of Environment and Natural Resources hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Export of Fishery Products (Sanitary) Regulations, 2006. Citation

2. All approved fish exporting establishments, factory and freezer vessels and other fishing vessels and personnel engaged in the business of export of fish or fishery products shall — Sanitary requirements

- (a) abide by all operational and managerial requirements relating to that business as prescribed by the Codex Alimentarius of the Food and Agriculture Organisation and the World Health Organisation; and
- (b) comply with any additional sanitary requirements prescribed by the importing country or community which are not covered by the standards set by the said Codex Alimentarius.
