**COCONUT AND OTHER PALMS, REGULATIONS
AND NOTICE***[26th January, 1926]*Mahe declared
infected.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister, under powers conferred by section 7(1) of the Plant Pests Act, has declared and hereby declares the whole of the Island of Mahe to be infected with scale insects attacking coconut and other palms.

In consequence of the above and under powers conferred by section 8(e) of the Act, the Minister has made the following regulations with effect from the date of the publication of this notice.

*Regulations*Coconut leaves not
to be moved from
Mahe.

1. It shall not be lawful for any person to transport or remove coconut leaves from Mahe to any part of Seychelles.

Coconut leaf basket
not to be taken on
board vessel.

2. It shall not be lawful for any person to transport, use or in any other way to be in possession of any coconut leaf basket (*capatia*) on board any vessel or other craft proceeding from Mahe to any other part of Seychelles.

Officer and
Agricultural
Department may
destroy leaves, etc.

3. It shall be lawful for any officer of the Agricultural Department to destroy any coconut leaves or coconut leaf baskets found on any vessel or other craft proceeding or about to proceed from Mahe to any other part of Seychelles without prejudice to the penalties enacted by the Act for breach of regulations made under the Act.
