PLANT PESTS REGULATIONS

G.N. 151/1952.

[9th June, 1952]

1. These regulations may be cited as the Plant Pests Regulations. Citation.
2. No person shall transport or remove or attempt to transport or remove coconut wood from any of the Islands declared to be infected with the pest *Melitoma Insulare* to any other Island in Seychelles. Transport or removal of coconut wood prohibited.
3. Any person contravening the provisions of regulation 2 shall be deemed guilty of an offence against the Act. Offences.
4. Any police officer or any officer of the Agricultural Department may seize coconut wood which is being or has been transported or removed in contravention of the provisions of regulation 2. Such wood shall be disposed of in any manner in which the Chief Agricultural Officer shall deem fit to order. Power to seize and dispose of wood.
5. The Chief Agricultural Officer may deliver a permit to any person to transport or remove samples of coconut wood wanted for scientific purposes, and any person thus transporting or removing coconut wood shall not be deemed guilty of an offence, the provisions of regulation 2 notwithstanding. Permission to transport or remove wood for scientific purposes.
