Na podlagi devetega odstavka 6. člena Zakona o fitofarmacevtskih sredstvih (Uradni list RS, št. 83/12) izdaja minister za kmetijstvo in okolje

PRAVILNIK
o strokovnih nalogah ocenjevanja aktivnih snovi in fitofarmacevtskih sredstev ter pogojih glede izobrazbe ocenjevalcev

1. člen
(vsebina)

Ta pravilnik določa strokovne naloge ocenjevanja aktivnih snovi in fitofarmacevtskih sredstev (v nadaljnjem besedilu: FFS) ter pogoje, ki jih morajo izpolnjevati ocenjevalci glede izobrazbe.

2. člen
(strokovne naloge ocenjevanja)

(1) Strokovne naloge ocenjevanja aktivnih snovi in FFS so:

1. ocenjevanje identitete, fizikalno-kemijskih in tehničnih lastnosti ter analitskih metod;

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Pursuant to paragraph nine of Article 6 of the Plant Protection Products Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia [*Uradni list RS*], No. 83/12) the Minister of Agriculture and the Environment hereby issues the following

RULES
on expert tasks of evaluation of active substances and plant protection products, and requirements for the education of evaluators

Article 1
(Subject)

These rules define the expert tasks of evaluation of active substances and plant protection products (hereinafter: PPPs) and the requirements that evaluators must meet concerning vocational education.

Article 2
(Expert tasks of evaluation)

(1) The expert tasks of evaluation of active substances and PPPs are as follows:

1. Evaluation of identity, physical, chemical and technical properties and analytical methods;

2. ocenjevanje uporabe in učinkovitosti ter dodatnih informacij;
3. ocenjevanje toksikoloških lastnosti in izpostavljenosti uporabnika;
4. ocenjevanje podatkov o ostankih v ali na tretiranih proizvodih, živilih in krmi;
5. ocenjevanje obnašanja in vpliva po uporabi v okolju in
6. ocenjevanje ekotoksikoloških lastnosti.

(2) K posameznim strokovnim nalogam ocenjevanja iz prejšnjega odstavka sodijo tudi:

- izdelava poročil o oceni za aktivne snovi in FFS v slovenskem in angleškem jeziku,
- zbiranje in upoštevanje pripomb držav članic Evropske unije;
- dajanje pripomb na ocene drugih držav članic Evropske unije;
- z ocenjevanjem povezano sodelovanje na sestankih in konferencah, ki jih za usklajevanje mnenj na področju ocenjevanja aktivnih snovi in FFS organizirajo Evropska Komisija, Evropska Agencija za varnost hrane in druge države članice Evropske unije in
- predstavljanje Republike Slovenije na mednarodnih dogodkih, povezanih z ocenjevanjem aktivnih snovi in FFS.

3. člen (pogoji glede izobrazbe)

Ocenjevalec aktivnih snovi in FFS mora imeti najmanj izobrazbo, pridobljeno po študijskih programih druge stopnje, v skladu z zakonom, ki ureja visoko šolstvo, oziroma izobrazbo, ki ustreza ravni izobrazbe, pridobljeni po študijskih programih druge stopnje, z naslednjega področja:

1. za ocenjevanje identitete, fizikalno-kemijskih in tehničnih lastnosti ter analitskih metod: s področja kemije;
2. za ocenjevanje uporabe in učinkovitosti ter dodatnih informacij: s področja agronomije – rastlinske smeri ali biologije;
3. za ocenjevanje toksikoloških lastnosti in izpostavljenosti uporabnika: s področja medicine, farmacije, kemije ali biologije;
4. za ocenjevanje podatkov o ostankih v ali na tretiranih proizvodih, živilih in krmi: s področja kemije, biologije, živilske tehnologije ali agronomije – rastlinske smeri;

2. Evaluation of intended use, efficacy and additional information;
3. Evaluation of toxicological properties and operator exposure;
4. Evaluation of data on residues on or in treated products, food and feed;
5. Evaluation of behaviour and effects after application in the environment; and
6. Evaluation of ecotoxicological properties.

(2) Expert tasks as referred to in the previous paragraph also comprise the following:

- Production of reports on evaluation of active substances and PPPs in Slovenian and English;
- Collecting and consideration of comments from Member States of the European Union;
- Commenting on the evaluations produced by other Member States of the European Union;
- Participation in meetings and conferences related to evaluation that are organised by the European Commission, EFSA and other Member States of the European Union for the coordination of expert opinions on evaluations of active substances and PPPs;
- Representation of the Republic of Slovenia at international events related to evaluations of active substances and PPPs.

Article 3 (Requirements concerning vocational education)

An evaluator of active substances and PPPs shall have at least education acquired in second-cycle study programmes, in accordance with legislation regulating higher education; or education corresponding to the level of education acquired in second-cycle study programmes, in the following fields of study:

1. For evaluation of identity of the substance, physical, chemical and technical properties and analytical methods: in the field of chemistry;
2. For evaluation of intended use, efficacy and additional information: in the field of agronomy – plant science or biology;
3. For evaluation of toxicological properties and operator exposure: in the field of medicine, pharmacy, chemistry or biology;
4. For evaluation of data on residues on or in treated products, food and feed: in the field of chemistry, biology, food science and technology or agronomy – plant science;

5. za ocenjevanje obnašanja in vpliva po uporabi v okolju: s področja biologije, kemije ali agronomije – rastlinske smeri;
6. za ocenjevanje ekotoksikoloških lastnosti: s področja biologije, farmacije, kemije, ali agronomije.

4. člen
(začetek veljavnosti)

Ta pravilnik začne veljati petnajsti dan po objavi v Uradnem listu Republike Slovenije.

5. For evaluation of behaviour and effects after application in the environment: in the field of biology, chemistry or agronomy – plant science;
6. For evaluation of ecotoxicological properties: in the field of biology, pharmacy, chemistry or agronomy.

Article 4
(Entry into force)

These rules shall enter into force on the fifteenth day following their publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia.
