CHAPTER 24.

BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

No. 9-1933. AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A BOARD OF AGRICULTURE.

[18th February, 1933.]

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Board of Agriculture Ordinance.

Agricultural Advisory Board.

- 2. (1) There shall be a Board to be called "The Board of Agriculture of St. Lucia" consisting of the Administrator, the Superintendent of Agriculture and not less than five persons interested in the agricultural industries of the Colony to be appointed by the Governor.
- (2) In the case of the absence on leave or through illness of any member of the Board the Governor may appoint any person similarly qualified to act in his stead.
- (3) Every member shall hold office for the term of three years from the date of his appointment.
- (4) The Administrator shall be the President of the Board and shall preside at all meetings thereof. Whenever he shall be unable to attend a meeting of the Board he may appoint a Deputy to act as President at such meeting.
- (5) Three members including the Chairman shall form a quorum.

Functions of Board.

3. (1) The Board shall be advisory and consultative and shall have no executive or administrative functions.

(2) It shall be the duty of the Board to advise upon all questions connected with the agricultural interests of the Colony which may be referred to it by the Governor or the Superintendent of Agriculture, and further it shall be competent for the Board to make recommendations to the Governor or the Superintendent of Agriculture in connection with such questions without previous reference.

4. The Board, subject to the approval of the Governor, Power to may make regulations for the conduct of the business and make regulations. proceedings of the Board.
