# [10.12.1954] THE FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT, 1954

An Act to protect the freshwater fihseries of the Sudan and to regulate and control fishing therein.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Freshwater Fisheries Act, 1954.

Application.

2. This Act or any specified sections thereof shall apply to all freshwater rivers and lakes in such part or parts of the Sudan as the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources may from time to time direct by notice published in the Gazette but shall not apply to any marine fisheries.<sup>1</sup>

### Interpretation

3. In this Act, unless the context otherwie requires—2 "boat" includes "canoe";

"to fish" means to capture or kill or to seek to capture or kill fish by any means other than a native spear or a native fish basket with a diameter not exceeding three feet or ninety centimetres or by a single hook

4. No person shall introduce any non-indigenous fish into Introduction the Sudan except under, and in accordance with the conditions of non-indigeof, a permit issued by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and prohibited. Natural Resources, who may in his absolute discretion refuse such permit.3

7. No person shall use any seine, gill or trammel net in any Control of freshwater river or lake unless such net conforms in all respects seine, gill or with any regulations in force for the time being governing trammel net. the same.

8. (1) No boat shall be used for fishing in any area specified Licences for by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources unless the same has been registered with him and bears a clearly displayed registration plate approved by him. The person applying for registration shall pay the fee prescribed therefor in the Schedule to this Act.6

(2) No registered boat may be so used unless there is in force a licence issued by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources in respect of such user by or on behalf of the person applying for a licence.7

- (3) Every licence shall be valid for one year from the date of issue and the person applying for the same shall pay therefor the fee prescribed in the Schedule to this Act.
- (4) Every licence shall specify the area in which and the purpose for which the user of the boat is licensed and the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources may refuse to license a boat for any particular area if in his opinion on account of the number of boats already licensed for that area it would be prejudicial to the resources thereof to license more.<sup>8</sup>

Fishing licences.

- 9. (1) No person shall fish unless he holds a valid fishing licence issued by the Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources authorizing him to do so and has paid the fee therefor prescribed in the Schedule to this Act.9
- (2) Every such licence shall remain in force up to the 31st. December of the year in which it was issued.

Power to make regulations.

- 10. (1) The Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources may make regulations—
  - (a) prescribing the types of nets that may or may not be used, the materials of which they may be made, their size and the size of their mesh, and the manner of their use;
  - (b) similar particulars of lines, traps and other means of fishing.
- (2) The Minister of Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources may at any time by order declare a close season for all fishing or for any fishing for any particular species of fish either generally or for any particular area, and may by like order prohibit absolutely all fishing or the fishing for any particular species of fish either generally or in any particular area.<sup>10</sup>
- (3) All regulations and orders made under this section shall be published in the Gazette.

11. (1) Any person contravening the provisions of this Act Offences and or of any regulations or orders made, or the conditions of any licence issued, thereunder shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Ls. 100 or to imprisonment not exceeding six months or to both, and in addition to the forfeiture of his licence.

(2) Offences under this Act shall be triable by a Magistrate of the First Class either summarily or non-summarily.
