**THE FISHERIES ACT, 1970**

(No. 6 OF 1970)

**REGULATIONS**

*Made under section 7*

THE FISHERIES (GENERAL AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1991

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (General Amendment) Regulations of 1991 and shall be read as one with the principal Regulations, 1989 and shall come into operation on the first day of July, 1991.

2. The principal Regulations, 1989 are hereby amended:

(i) in Regulation 13 by adding after sub-regulation  
(4) the following:—

“4A. Application for a prawn fishing licence shall be made in Form No. 5(c)”;

(ii) in the First Schedule by adding a new Form:—  
“5(c) Application for a licence for prawn fishing”;

(iii) in the Third Schedule by deleting paragraph (a), (b) and (c) and substituting for it the following new paragraphs:—

“(a) Fishing vessel registration and transfer fee shall be charged according to ownership and mode of fishing operation.

**OWNERSHIP**

(i) Registration fee for prawn fishing vessel	Tshs. 100/- for a vessel up to 11.0 metres in length or 20 GRT, and Tshs. 1000/- for a vessel above 11.0m. or 20GRT	10,000.00 for a vessel up to 150 GRT and 30,000.00 for a vessel above 150 GRT.
(ii) Registration fee for any fishing vessel other than a prawn fishing vessel	100/-	2,000.00
(iii) Sport fishing vessel	100/-	40.00

(iv) Transfer fee for any type fishing vessel shall be the same rate as the registration fee.

(b) Classes of fishing vessels and fees for fishing vessel licences (form 4) shall be charged according to the Gross Registered Tonnage (GRT) and ownership of the vessel.
