An Act to amend certain written laws

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1995.

Short title

2. The written laws set out in the First and Second columns of the Schedule to this Act are amended in the manner specified opposite those laws in the third column of the schedule.

Amendment of certain written Laws

THIRD COLUMN

The Penal Code, 1966, is hereby amended—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section 114, by deleting the words "five hundred shillings" and substituting for them, the words "fifty thousand shillings".
- (b) in subsection (1) of section 175, by deleting the words "two thousand shillings" and substituting for them the words "two hundred thousand shillings".

The Police Force
and Prisons Service
Commission Act, 1990

The Police Force and Prisons Service
Commission Act, 1990, is hereby amended.

-(a) by deleting subsections (2) to (5), and substituting for them respectively the following provisions:

"(2) The disciplinary authority in respect of officers above the rank of Assistant Commissioner is vested in the Commission and the final disciplinary authority is vested in the President.

The Food (Control of
Quality) Act, 1978

The Act is amended in Section 37 by
deleting paragraph (b) of Subsection (2) and
substituting for it the following paragraph

"(b) destroy or dispose of that food
in any other way at the expense
of the owner of the food; and
where the owner fails to comply
with this provision, the
authorized officer may destroy or
dispose of the food and the
expense shall be recoverable as a
civil debt".
