ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES NO. 585/2019 RE: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE OFFICE OF COORDINATION ON PREVENTION AND COMBATING ILLEGAL UNREGULATED AND UNREPORTED FISHING

Due to the undertaken action to solve the problems of IUU fishing is the operational integration with key various agencies and their specific missions, each mission having the connection with other, coupled with the meeting between Thai government delegation and EU government delegation which the cabinet approved on 5 February 2562 to hold this meeting continuously (at least once per year) in accordance with the requirement of the co-working groups between Thai government and European Commission in combating IUU Fishing in order to achieve the continuity of negotiation and preparation of information on combating IUU Fishing in Thailand and to move in one direction.

Therefore, Department of Fisheries, hereby issues the Order to establish the office of coordination on prevention and combating IUU to have the roles and duties as follows:

(1) To collect and analyze the information concerning the prevention and combating illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing.

(2) To provide a report concerning the results of operation on prevention and combating IUU fishing.

(3) To coordinate and integrate with relevant government agencies within the Department of Fisheries and other national and foreign agencies with relevant missions.

(4) To undertake other actions assigned by Director General of the Department of Fisheries.

This Order shall come into force immediately from the date of its issuance this Order.
