THE CONSERVATION OF WILD LIFE ACT, CHAP. 67:01

REGULATIONS

Made by the Minister under section 24 of the Conservation of Wild Life Act

THE CONSERVATION OF WILD LIFE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1991

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Conservation of Wild Life Citation (Amendment) Regulations, 1991.
- 2. The Conservation of Wild Life Regulations are amended by substituting Regulations for regulation 2 the following:
 - " 2. (1) State Game Licences issued under section 6 of the Act shall—
 - (a) be in the form set out in the First Schedule to these regulations;
 - (b) be issued by Game Wardens anthorised by the Minister for the purpose;
 - (c) be issued separately, each of a different colour, in respect of each of the following animals, up to a maximum of three State Game Licences for person:

Alligator or Cayman;

Lizards;

Agouti;

Armadil'e (Tattoo);

Deer (in Trinicad only);

Lappo;

Quenk (Peccary or Wild Hog);

Waterfowl, that is to say, the birds listed in Part II of the Second Schedule to the Act with the exception

- (i) Amazona Amazonica Amazonica, Lim or Common Amazon Parrot;
- (ii) Corbeau, Common Town (Coragyps);
- (iii) Ramier or Pigeon (all kinds);
- (d) expire on the last day of February in every year;
- (e) on expiry, be returned to a Game Warden at the office of the Forestry Division at which the licences were issued.
- (2) No person shall have in his possession or knowingly cause to be issued to him, four or more State Game Licences.
