1. Cement, clinker production, grinding and packaging plants
2. Ceramic and porcelain plants
3. Lime and plaster plants
4. Block marble processing locations
5. Stone and mineral quarries
6. Mineral enrichment plants
7. Brick and tile plants
8. Mineral ore storage facilities
9. Small production sites for products made of lead, tin and similar materials
10. Prefabricated construction materials
11. Foundry, roller mills and steel plants
12. Plants producing, assembling, repairing metal ware, plastic coating and enameling plants
13. Ship building, and dismantling sites, port and container terminals
14. Alcohol production sites
15. Cellulose and celluloid plants
16. Coal washing, sieving, and briquette plants
17. Plants and storage areas for flammable materials
18. Pulp and paper plants
19. Rubber-ware and plastic-ware plants, tire and tire coating plants, using engine power of 50 HP or more
20. Plastic raw materials plant
21. Explosives, fuse, sparkler, carbide, liquid acetylene, synthetic gas production and filling plants and storage facilities
22. Nitrogen, oxygen, carbon dioxide, fluorine, ammonium and compounds production, filling and storage facilities
23. Soap plants with a daily capacity of 500 kg

25. Plants for producing glycerin, oil acids, sulphuric acid, hydrochloric acid, chloride and similar substances
26. Synthetic paints, wax and lacquer plants

^(*) Buffer zone is defined in the Regulation. This is the area not less than 2500 meters from the ecological area, if borders exist, and if not then from the wetland area.
