

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ACT.

Statutory Instrument 38—2.

The Animal Diseases (Declaration of Diseases) Instrument.

(Under section 1(d) of the Act.)

1. Citation.

This Instrument may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Declaration of Diseases) Instrument.

2. Declaration of diseases.

It is declared that the following diseases shall be included in the term “disease” for the purposes of the Act—

- (a) all tick-borne diseases of cattle;
- (b) atrophic rhinitis of pigs;
- (c) bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE);
- (d) brucellosis;
- (e) epi-vaginitis;
- (f) fowl pox;
- (g) infectious bursal disease (Gumboro disease);
- (h) Johne’s disease;
- (i) lumpy skin disease of cattle;
- (j) Newcastle disease of poultry;
- (k) peste des petits ruminants;
- (l) trichomoniasis;
- (m) vibriosis.
