1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Uganda Tea Authority (Prescription of Forms) Regulations.

2. Application for permission to erect a tea factory.

The application for permission to erect a tea factory shall be in the form laid out in Form A of the Schedule to these Regulations.

3. Application for a tea manufacturing licence.

The application for a tea manufacturing licence shall be in the form laid out in Form B of the Schedule to these Regulations.

4. Permit for erecting a tea factory.

The permit to be granted by the Minister for erecting a tea factory shall be in the form laid down in Form C of the Schedule to these Regulations.

5. Tea manufacturing licence.

The tea manufacturing licence to be granted by the Minister shall be in the form laid out in Form D of the Schedule to these Regulations.
