

THE WATER ACT.

Statutory Instrument 152—7.

The Water (Disconnecting and Reconnecting Charges) Regulations.¹ *(Under section 94 of the Act.)*

1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Water (Disconnecting and Reconnecting Charges) Regulations.

2. Disconnecting and reconnecting changes.

(1) When the water authority has cut off or withdrawn the supply of water to any premises under section 95 of the Act, there shall be payable to the water authority by the person liable for payment of the water rates or other charges a disconnecting charge of ten shillings.

(2) Before the supply of water to any premises in respect of which the water authority has cut off or withdrawn the supply is resumed on the application of the person liable to pay the disconnecting charge, that person shall pay to the water authority in addition to the amount due for water rates, other charges and the disconnecting charge a reconnecting charge of ten shillings.
