Statutory Instrument 152—9.

The Water (Uganda Schools) (Charges by Meter) Regulations.¹ *(Under section 94 of the Act.)*

1. Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Water (Uganda Schools) (Charges by Meter) Regulations.

2. Interpretation.

In these Regulations, “school” shall have the meaning assigned to it by section 1 of the Education Act or any Act amending or replacing that Act.

3. Charges for water.

(1) The charges for water supplied to schools within a water supply area or to which a supply has been authorised under section 96 of the Act shall be assessed on consumption as registered by a meter at the rate of three shillings per thousand gallons; except that until a school is fitted with a meter, it shall continue to pay the general rate applicable.

(2) No deposit shall be required to be paid by the consumer.

(3) Meter rent shall be charged in accordance with the Schedule to these Regulations.²

(4) The general water rate shall not be charged in addition to the charge made under subregulation (1) of this regulation.

For a $\frac{3}{8}$ " meter	2 50 per month
For a $\frac{1}{2}$ " meter	3 00 per month
For a $\frac{3}{4}$ " meter	4 00 per month
For a 1" meter	6 50 per month
For any other size of meter	10% per year of the value of the meter delivered and fixed on any premises
