THE GAME (PRESERVATION AND
CONTROL) ACT.

Statutory Instrument 226—1.

The Game (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order.

(Sections 2, 50A and 52 of the Act).

1. THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order.
2. The persons specified in the First Schedule to this Order are declared to be authorised officers for the purposes of the Act.
3. The persons specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are declared to be game wardens for the purposes of the Act.
4. The persons specified in the Third Schedule to this Order are declared to be game guards for the purposes of the Act.
5. The government of every Kingdom and the administration of every District is authorised to issue supplementary licences for the area under its authority, and the proceeds of any fees paid in respect of any such licence shall form part of the revenues of the government or administration by which the licence is issued:

Provided that in the Kingdoms of Ankole, Toro and Bunyoro and in the Districts of Acholi and Karamoja such supplementary licences shall be issued by the game warden in any such Kingdom and District on behalf of the government or administration, as the case may be.
6. The forms set out in the Fourth Schedule to this Order shall be used for the licences to which they are appropriate.
