The Game (Karuma Falls Hunting Area) Order.
(Sections 71 and 72 of the Act).

1. (1) THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (Karuma Falls Hunting Area) Order.

(2) This Order shall apply to the area specified in the First Schedule to this Order other than such part thereof as has been declared to be a game reserve known as the Karuma Game Reserve.

2. The hunting of any species of scheduled animals specified in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

3. In respect of any species of scheduled animals specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order the number of each of such species which may be hunted in any one calendar year shall be the number respectively set out in the second column of such Schedule.

4. It is hereby prescribed that on the issue of a permit to hunt any species of the scheduled animals specified in the Third Schedule to this Order there shall be paid to the Government of the Kingdom of Bunyoro the basic fee as specified in that Schedule and, in addition, the fee respectively specified in respect of each of such species in the third, fourth and fifth columns of that Schedule.

5. It is hereby declared that a request has been received in writing from the Government of the Kingdom of Bunyoro to prescribe the fees specified in the fifth column of the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of permits issued to *bona fide* residents of the Kingdom.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The area comprised within the following boundaries—

Commencing at the Atura Ferry; thence following the Atura-Masindi road south-westwards to its junction with the Katulakire road; thence northwards along the Katulakire road to Katulakire village; thence to

the summit of Rere Hill; thence in a straight line running in a north-westerly direction to the summit of Lating Hill; thence following the Murchison Falls National Park boundary in a north-easterly direction to the Victoria Nile; thence following the Nile upstream to the point of commencement at the Atura Ferry.
