**The Game (Buhuka Hunting Area) Order.**  
*(Sections 71 and 72 of the Act).*

1. (1) THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (Buhuka Hunting Area) Order.

(2) This Order shall apply to the area specified in the First Schedule to this Order.

2. The hunting of any species of scheduled animals specified in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

3. In respect of any species of scheduled animals specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order the number of each of such species which may be hunted in any one calendar year shall be the number respectively set out in the second column of such Schedule.

4. It is hereby prescribed that on the issue of a permit to hunt any species of the scheduled animals specified in the Third Schedule to this Order there shall be paid to the Government of the Kingdom of Bunyoro the basic fee as specified in that Schedule and, in addition, the fee respectively specified in respect of each of such species in the third, fourth and fifth columns of that Schedule.

5. It is hereby declared that a request has been received in writing from the Government of the Kingdom of Bunyoro to prescribe the fees specified in the fifth column of the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of permits issued to *bona fide* residents of the Kingdom.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The area comprised within the following boundaries—

All that area known as Buhuka in the Kingdom of Bunyoro; bounded on the east by the foot of the Lake Albert escarpment; to the west by the shoreline of Lake Albert; and to the north and south by the two points where the east and west boundaries meet.
