CONTROL) ACT.**

The Game (South Karamoja Hunting Area) Order.

1. (1) THIS ORDER may be cited as the Game (South Karamoja Hunting Area) Order.

(2) This Order shall apply to the area specified in the First Schedule to this Order other than such part thereof as has been declared to be a game reserve known as Bokora Corridor Game Reserve.

2. The hunting of any species of scheduled animals specified in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

3. In respect of any species of scheduled animals specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order the number of each of such species which may be hunted in any one calendar year shall be the number respectively set out in the second column of such Schedule.

4. It is hereby prescribed that on the issue of a permit to hunt any species of the scheduled animals specified in the Third Schedule to this Order there shall be paid to the Karamoja District Administration the basic fee as specified in that Schedule and, in addition, the fee respectively specified in respect of each of such species in the third, fourth and fifth columns of that Schedule.

5. It is hereby declared that a request has been received in writing from the Karamoja District Administration to prescribe the fees specified in the fifth column of the Third Schedule to this Order in respect of permits issued to *bona fide* residents of the Karamoja District.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The area comprised within the following boundaries—

Commencing at the point where the Adilang-Moroto road crosses the Karamoja-Acholi District boundary; thence in an easterly direction following the Adilang-Moroto road to its junction with the Soroti-Moroto road; thence in a north-easterly direction following the Soroti-Moroto road to Moroto; thence in a north-easterly direction following the Moroto-Nakiloro-Lodwar road to the point where it crosses the Uganda-Kenya boundary; thence in a southerly direction following the Uganda-Kenya boundary to the point where it meets the Karamoja-Sebei District boundary; thence following the Karamoja-Sebei District boundary to the point where it meets the Debasien Animal Sanctuary boundary; thence in a northerly and westerly direction following the Debasien Animal Sanctuary boundary to the point where it meets the Teso-Karamoja District boundary; thence in a northerly and north-westerly direction following the Karamoja-Teso-Lango-Acholi District boundaries to the point of commencement.
