**The Control of Salmonella in Poultry (Amendment) Order 2019**

*Made* - - - - *21st March 2019*

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1*

The Secretary of State makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1 and 8 of the Animal Health Act 1981(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Salmonella in Poultry (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

**Amendment of the Control of Salmonella in Poultry Order 2007**

2. In article 3 of the Control of Salmonella in Poultry Order 2007(b), before paragraph (a), insert—

“(za) Regulation (EC) No 2160/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the control of salmonella and other food-borne zoonotic agents(c);”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order amends the Control of Salmonella in Poultry Order (S.I. 2007/3574) to designate the Secretary of State as competent authority in respect of England for the purposes of Regulation (EC) No 2160/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the control of salmonella and other food-borne zoonotic agents (OJ No L 325, 12.12.2003, p.1).

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no, or no significant, impact on the private or voluntary sector is foreseen.

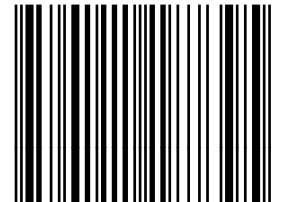
