**The Water Industry Commissioner for Scotland (Dissolution)
Order 2007**

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 2 of the Water Services etc. (Scotland) Act 2005(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Water Industry Commissioner for Scotland (Dissolution) Order 2007 and comes into force on 1st October 2007.

Appointed date

2. The appointed date for the dissolution of the office of Water Industry Commissioner for Scotland(b) is 1st October 2007.
