1. Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn gwneud diwygiadau pellach i Reoliadau Bwydydd Anifeiliaid (Cymru) 2006 (O.S. 2006/116 (Cy.14) fel y'i diwygiwyd eisoes gan O.S. 2006/617 (Cy.69), O.S. 2006/2928 (Cy.263), O.S. 2006/3256 (Cy.296), O.S. 2007/3171 (Cy.277), O.S. 2008/1806 (Cy.174) ac O.S. 2009/106 (Cy.20)) ("y Rheoliadau Bwydydd Anifeiliaid").

2. Mae'r Rheoliadau hyn yn darparu ar gyfer gweithredu Cyfarwyddeb y Comisiwn 2009/8/EC sy'n diwygio Atodiad I i Gyfarwyddeb 2002/32/EC Senedd Ewrop a'r Cyngor ynghylch y lefelau uchaf ar gyfer trosglwyddo'n anochel gocsidiostatau neu histomonostatau mewn bwyd anifeiliaid ar gyfer rhywogaethau nad ydynt yn darged (OJ Rhif L40, 11.2.2009, t.19).

3. Mae'r Rheoliadau yn diwygio Atodlen 5 i'r Rheoliadau Bwydydd Anifeiliaid drwy ychwanegu Pennod E sy'n pennu cyfyngiadau penodedig o ran trosglwyddo i fwydydd anifeiliaid ar gyfer rhywogaethau nad ydynt yn darged ychwanegion sootchnegol penodol at fwyd anifeiliaid (*rheoliad 2 a'r Atodlen*).

1. These Regulations make further amendments to the Feeding Stuffs (Wales) Regulations 2006 (S.I. 2006/116 (W.14) as already amended by S.I. 2006/617 (W.69), S.I. 2006/2928 (W.263), S.I. 2006/3256 (W.296), S.I. 2007/3171 (W.277), S.I. 2008/1806 (W.174) and S.I. 2009/106 (W.20)) ("the Feeding Stuffs Regulations").

2. These Regulations provide for the implementation of Commission Directive 2009/8/EC amending Annex I to Directive 2002/32/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum levels of unavoidable carry-over of coccidiostats or histomonostats in non-target feed (OJ No. L40, 11.2.2009, p.19).

3. The Regulations amend Schedule 5 to the Feeding Stuffs Regulations by the addition of a Chapter E setting specified limits in relation to the carry-over into non-target feeding stuffs of certain zootechnical feed additives, (*regulation 2 and the Schedule*).

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru yn gwneud y Rheoliadau canlynol drwy arfer y pwerau a roddwyd gan adrannau 66(1), 74A a 84 o Ddeddf Amaethyddiaeth 1970(1).

Bu ymgynghori yn ystod y broses o baratoi'r Rheoliadau hyn yn unol â gofynion adran 84(1) o Ddeddf Amaethyddiaeth 1970 neu, fel y bo'n briodol, o Erthygl 9 o Reoliad (EC) Rhif 178/2002 Senedd Ewrop a'r Cyngor(2) sy'n gosod egwyddorion a gofynion cyffredinol cyfraith bwyd, yn sefydlu Awdurdod Diogelwch Bwyd Ewrop ac yn gosod gweithdrefnau o ran materion diogelwch bwyd.

1. Enw'r Rheoliadau hyn yw Rheoliadau Bwyd Anifeiliaid (Sylweddau Annymunol Penodedig) (Cymru) 2009 a deuant i rym ar 23 Tachwedd 2009.

Cafodd swyddogaethau "*the Ministers*", i'r graddau y maent yn arferadwy o ran Cymru, eu trosglwyddo i Gynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru gan O.S. 1999/672 a'u trosglwyddo wedi hynny i Weinidogion Cymru gan baragraff 30 o Atodlen 11 i Ddeddf Llywodraeth Cymru 2006 (2006 p.32). Cafodd adran 74A ei mewnosod gan Ddeddf y Cymunedau Ewropeaidd 1972 (1972 p.68), Atodlen 4, paragraff 6.

The Feed (Specified Undesirable Substances) (Wales) Regulations 2009

Made 27 October 2009

*Laid before the National

Coming into force 23 November 2009

The Welsh Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 66(1), 74A and 84 of the Agriculture Act 1970(1).

There has been consultation during the preparation of these Regulations in accordance with the requirements of section 84(1) of the Agriculture Act 1970 or as appropriate of Article 9 of Regulation (EC) No. 178/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council(2) laying down the general principles and requirements of food law, establishing the European Food Safety Authority and laying down procedures in matters of food safety.

Title and Commencement

1. The title of these Regulations is the Feed (Specified Undesirable Substances) (Wales) Regulations 2009 and they come into force on 23 November 2009.

The definition of "the Ministers" was amended by the Transfer of Functions (Wales) (No. 1) Order 1978 (S.I. 1978/272), Schedule 5, paragraph 1. Functions of "the Ministers", so far as exercisable in relation to Wales, were transferred to the National Assembly for Wales by S.I. 1999/672 and thereafter transferred to the Welsh Ministers by paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to the Government of Wales Act 2006 (2006 c.32). Section 74A was inserted by the European Communities Act 1972 (1972 c.68), Schedule 4, paragraph 6.
