PLANT PROTECTION (KAVA EXPORT FEE)

Order 17 of 1999

To prescribe the export fee for kava.

1. Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:

"kava" means natural extracts, dried roots, stumps (chips) and/or basal stems from selected varieties of the plan species Piper methysticum;

"exporter" means a Ni-Vanuatu or a group of Ni-Vanuatu involved in the export of kava.

2. Application for export authority

- (1) Any person may apply to the Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service for an export authority for the exportation of kava.
- (2) The Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service may grant or refuse an application made under sub-section (1).

3. Kava export fee

- (1) The fee payable for the export of kava is VT 30,000 and shall be paid annually before the 31st day of January.
- (2) Any person applying for an export authority after June of each year shall pay a fee of VT 15,000.
- (3) The fee payable under this section is not refundable.

4. Persons liable for payment of export fee

An exporter of kava, dried kava or kava-related products shall pay the fee specified in section 3, to the Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service.
