AGRICULTURAL FEES ACT [CAP 74]

Agricultural Fees Regulation Order No. 177 of 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 of the Agricultural Fees Act [CAP 74], I, the Honourable WILLIE DANIEL KALO Minister of Agriculture, Livestock, Forestry, Fisheries and Biosecurity, by Order make this Regulation.

1 Interpretation

In this Regulation, unless the contrary intention appears:

escort means a Biosecurity Officer escorting the movement of a regulated article or good to a specified area for the purpose of assessment and monitoring;

import risk analysis (IRA) means the assessment of the biosecurity risks associated with the import of a range of goods which by its nature, condition, or origin, may expose the natural resources of Vanuatu to potential harm caused by quarantine pests.

service calls means the visits made from a quarantine depot to other premises to carry out the quarantine or phytosanitary duties.

2 Fees for permit services

The fees payable for permit services are set out under the Schedule, Table 1.

3 Fees for import inspection services

The fees payable for import inspection services are set out under the Schedule, Table 2.

4 Fees for treatment services

The fees payable for treatment services are set out under the Schedule, Table 3.

5 Fees for conveyance clearance services – vessel

The fees payable for conveyance clearance services for vessel are set out under the Schedule, Table 4.

6 Fees for conveyance clearance services – aircraft

The fees payable for conveyance clearance services for vessel are set out under the Schedule, Table 5.

7 Fees for exports of plants and plant products services

The fees payable for exports of plants and plant products services are set out under the Schedule, Table 6.

8 Fees for facility accreditation and monitoring services

The fees payable for facility accreditation and monitoring services are set out under the Schedule, Table 7.

9 Fees for exports of animals and animal products services

The fees payable for export of animals and animal products services are set out under the Schedule, Table 8.

10 Fees for veterinary services

The fees payable for veterinary services are set out under the Schedule, Table 9.

11 Fees for other services

The fees payable for other services are set out under the Schedule, Table 10.

12 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is made.
