The Forests Ordinance

(Laws. Volume IV, Cap. 105)

Protected Forest Area No. 236: Kapalala

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources by sections five and six of the Forests Ordinance the area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared a Protected Forest Area and no person shall without a license do any of the following acts in the said area:

- (a) fell, cut, take, work, burn, injure or remove any forest produce;
- (b) squat, reside, build any but or livestock enclosure, construct or re-open any saw-pit or road:
- (c) fire any grass or undergrowth or light or assist in lighting any fire or allow any fire lighted by himself or his servants to enter the said area.
- (d) graze livestock or allow livestock to trespass;
- (e) clear, cultivate or break up land for cultivation or other purposes;
- (f) enter or be in or upon-
 - (i) the said area while in possession of any implement for the cutting, taking, working or removal of forest produce unless he be a bona fide traveller upon a road or path in the area: or
 - (ii) the said area, or portion thereof, in any manner or for any purpose contrary to any order made by the Chief Forest Officer and published in the Cazette.

SCHEDULE

PROTECTED FOREST AREA NO. 236: KAPALAUA

Starting at Forest Department Beacon Y on the junction of the Milenge-Kapalala Road with the Munushi Forest Compound Road the boundary follows along the Milenge-Kapalala Road in a westerly direction on a true bearing of 271° approximately for a distance of 10,800 feet approximately to Forest Department Beacon Z; thence in a straight line in a northerly direction on a true bearing of 359° approximately for a distance of 7,600 feet approximately to Forest Department Beacon W on the edge of the Munushi Dambo; thence following this Dambo in an easterly direction in a straight line on a true bearing of 91° approximately to Forest Department Beacon F on this Dambo; thence in a southerly direction in a straight line on a true bearing of 179° for a distance of 7,600 feet approximately to the Forest Department Beacon Y the point of starting.

The above-described area, in extent 1,884 acres approximately, is shown bordered green on Plan No. F.R.312 deposited in the office of the Surveyor-General, signed by him and dated 10th December, 1969.
