*NOTIFICATION*

MAHARASHTRA WATER RESOURCES REGULATORY AUTHORITY (FEES AND CHARGES) REGULATIONS, 2013

No. MWRRRA 2010/CBR/(54).—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority Act, 2005 (Mah. XVIII of 2005), the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority hereby makes the following Regulations :—

CHAPTER I

GENERAL

1. *Short Title, Object, Commencement and Extent.*—(1) These Regulations may be called the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority (Fees & Charges) Regulations, 2010.

(2) The object of these Regulations is to fix the fees and charges for all applications made to the Authority as specified in these Regulations which is to be paid by the applicant/petitioner.

(3) These Regulations shall come into force on the date of notification in the *Official Gazette*.

(4) These Regulations shall apply to all matters within the jurisdiction of the Authority including all applications, pending before the Authority on the date of publication of these Regulations.

2. *Definitions.*—(1) In these Regulations unless, the context otherwise requires,—

(a) 'Act' means the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority Act, 2005 (Mah. XVIII of 2005), as amended from time to time;

(b) 'Authority' means the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority established under Section 3 of the Act;

(2) Terms not defined in these Regulations will have the same meaning as assigned to them under the Act or under the Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2013.

(3) In construing these Regulations the singular shall include the plural and vice versa.

3. *Fees on Application.*—(1) Every application made to the Authority shall be accompanied by fees or charges specified in Schedule I to these Regulations.

(2) The fees or charges payable under these Regulations shall be paid by a bank draft or pay order drawn in favour of the 'Secretary, Maharashtra Water Resources Regulatory Authority' payable at Mumbai or may be paid in cash at the office of the Authority for an amount not exceeding Rs.500. A photocopy of the cash receipt should be attached to the application.

(3) Any penalty ordered by the Authority under Section 26 of the Act shall be paid within 30 (thirty) days of the order of the Authority or within extended time as may be allowed by the Authority.

(4) The fee or charges or penalty received by the Authority under these Regulations shall be deposited in the designated bank account of the Authority.

4. *Power to Amend.*—The Authority may, at any time, vary, alter, modify or amend any provision of these Regulations.

5. *Power to remove difficulties.*—If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these Regulations, the Authority may, by general or specific order, make such provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of the Act, as may appear to be necessary for removing the difficulty.
