FUR FARMS REGULATION

Fur-bearing animals

1 For the purposes of the Act and this Regulation, the following animals are prescribed as fur-bearing animals:

- (b) a fur farmer's annual report under section 7(2) of the Act in the form set out in Form 2 of the Schedule, and
- (c) a fur farm export permit in the form set out in Form 3 of the Schedule.
