Nr. 82 of 26.2.1993

On establishment of tariffs in the forestry sector

Upon proposal of the general directorate of forestry the Council of Ministers has decided:

1. Tariffs of sale of standing wood materials for parcels of forest units ("economie forestali"), where there are automobile roads, have to be on the basis of table 1, hereinafter. Tariffs for beech, oak, pine and fir species belong to the third site-class (class of fertility of soil)

2. For the first and the second site-class of beach, oak, pine and fir tree species, the value of these is increased 30% of the tariffs' value of the third bonitet, for the fourth and fifth, the value of tariffs is decreased of 10% of the third site-class; for other wood species the tariffs are fixed.

3. For the parcels, for "economie forestali" without automobile roads, for investments that will be done for their exploitation by state enterprises with financial means from their own resources, by physical persons, native or foreign ones, according to report of lek investments that will be done for one m3 of standing industrial wood materials the correction of the basis of the tariffs for every site-class is as follows:

- up to 100 lek per m3 material investments: coefficient 0.9

- from 101 to 200 lek per m3 material investments: coefficient 0.8

- above 201 lek per m3 material investments: coefficient 0.7

These tariffs are the same for joint ventures, foreign juridical and physical persons.

4. The sale of standing material will be done by auction, having as a target the defined tariffs in table 1 that is attached hereinafter.

5. Tariffs for secondary forestry production shall be as in table 2 attached hereinafter.

6. Tariffs for approved deforestations in the forest estate shall be as in table 3 attached hereinafter.

7. Tariffs for forestry utilization or forest areas utilized for recreation, tourism and health shall be as in table 4 attached hereinafter.

8. Tariffs for the reward of damages caused in the forest estate shall be as in table 5 attached hereinafter.

9. Every other provision that is in contrast with this decision is repealed.

This decision enters into force immediately.
