PUBLIC HEALTH (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2017

AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act, Cap. 353 of the Laws of Antigua and Barbuda to give to the Minister with responsibility for health such powers as are prescribed to the Governor General under the Act

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows—

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Act, 2017.

2. Interpretation

In this Act—

“principal Act” means the Public Health Act, Cap 353.

3. Amendment of the principal Act

The principal Act is amended in its entirety by -

- (a) repealing the words "the Governor-General" wheresoever these words appear in the principal Act and replacing these words with "the Minister"; and

- (b) repealing the words "by proclamation" wheresoever these words appear in the principal Act and replacing these words with "by Order published in the *Gazette*".
