THE FISHERIES (RESTRICTION ON METHODS OF FRESH WATER FISHING)
REGULATIONS DATED THE 8 TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1978 MADE UNDER
SECTION 6 OF THE PRESERVED BY SECTION 32(3)(a) OF THE
INTERPRETATION ACT.

1. CITATION. These regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Restriction on Methods of Fresh-Water Fishing) Regulations.

2. PLACES WHERE FISHING BY ROD AND LINE ONLY MAY TAKE PLACE. Any person who takes or attempts to take fish from those areas within Antigua and Barbuda known as Potworks Dam, Oliver's Dam, Bethesda Dam and Collins Dam by any method other than by rod and line shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not less than two hundred dollars and not exceeding four hundred dollars:

Provided that the provisions of this regulation shall not apply where prior permission in writing has been given by the Minister for such period and under such conditions as he thinks fit.

3. NON-APPLICATION OF REGULATIONS. These regulations shall not apply to any fishing carried out within off-shore waters of Antigua and Barbuda.
