THE NATIONAL PARKS (NELSON'S DOCKYARD PARKING) REGULATIONS MADE BY
THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 26 OF THE NATIONAL PARKS ACT

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Parks
(Nelson's Dockyard Parking) Regulations.

2. In these Regulations -

Interpretation

"Dockyard" means the area of the Nelson's Dockyard within
the outer gate thereof;

"valid parking card" means a permit issued by the National
Parks Commissioner permitting parking of vehicles at
Designated areas.

**Permitted
Parking**

3. (1) No person shall park within the Dockyard gate except
he is the holder of a valid parking card.

(2) Subject to subregulation (1), no person shall park within the
Dockyard except -

(a) in the case of the driver of a taxi registered with the Parks
Commissioner to operate at the Dockyard, in an area adjacent to the
Admiral's House designated for such parking; and

(b) in the case of the operators of motor cycles; in the area
designated for such parking; and

(c) in the case of the operators of motor cycles; in the area
designated for such parking.

**Vehicular
traffic
prohibited**

4. (1) No person shall drive a vehicle within the Dockyard except -

- (a) for parking in accordance with regulation 2; or
- (b) for delivering, picking up or dropping off supplies, supplies, equipment or passengers.

(2) Unless prior written permission has been given by the National Parks Commissioner, no person shall leave a vehicle within the Dockyard while delivering, picking up or dropping off supplies, equipment or passengers for longer than thirty minutes.

(3) The gate attendants employed by the National Parks Authority may make such inquiries as they deem necessary to verify the purpose of entry of a vehicle.

Penalty

5. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these Regulations is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of one thousand dollars.
